## Cargo Securement

### Cargo Securement and Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) Standards: Designed to protect the public and the workplace

#### All loads on vehicles and trailers must be secured against movement and dislodging during normal operations:

- Vehicles less than 4,500 kg follow Kaynic Construction's standards.
- Vehicles greater than 4,500 kg follow *National Safety Code Standard 10*.



#### Alberta Transport – Commercial Safety Regulation

- All cargo must not leak, spill, blow from, fall from, fall through, or otherwise be dislodged from a commercial vehicle.

#### TDG Regulations – 5.4 Loading and Securing

- A person must load and secure dangerous goods in such a way as to prevent, under normal conditions of transport, damage to the means of containment or to the means of transport that could lead to an accidental release of the dangerous goods.
